



## ***Midwinter Tomato Plants!!***

### **But why buy tomato plants from Filbert Acres?**

#### **Quality**

Stocky, healthy, with blossoms. Our plants will be timed well with our northwest season and hardened off to minimize transplant shock. If you are going to spend the time to grow quality fruit, start right! (ORGANIC? Not certified, most organic seeds, all organic soil/inputs)

#### **Variety**

When you have some favorite varieties, it can be frustrating to find them at the right time to plant. Maybe the nurseries don't carry all the varieties you want; maybe they don't carry *any* variety you want.

#### **Value**

The trip from the farm is the only traveling these plants will suffer, and with a little luck, they'll have some nice blooms and some tiny green fruit on them as you plant them into your garden.

### **But what is the catch?**

To get you this quality, to make these varieties available, and to do it at a great value, we need to plan ahead and start your tomato plants indoors by March 1. So you need to order now and pay at least half up front. We can only accept orders this year through February 22.

### **But do I really have to act now?**

**Yes!!** Or you may sadly realize in May that you have to wait until next January to order!

<b>Cougar Red</b> – new (-ish) from WSU, grown and tested for cool summer/short season. Meaty, balanced flavor, vigorous, semi-determinate, open-pollinated!	Medium, red	

<b>Black Prince</b> – from Russian, this indeterminate plant performs well in cooler regions, mahogany skin, green shoulders and florid, green/red striped flesh	Medium, dark	
<b>Sweet Millions</b> – heavy producer of sweet cherry tomatoes. Very disease resistant, early, great flavor, indeterminate	Cherry, red	
<b>Stupice</b> – cold-tolerant, sweet, red, slightly oval, consistently gets high marks for taste throughout the summer. From Czechoslovakia. Indeterminate	Medium, red	
<b>Green Zebra</b> – zesty flavor, green skin, mottled streaks. Consistent producer and one of our favorites. Indeterminate	Medium, green	
<b>Monica</b> – large Roma performing well in Pac NW, our favorite Roma of 2013 Determinate	Roma, red	
<b>Sweet Hearts</b> – sweet grape with crack resistance, drop resistance. Indeterm.	Grape, red	
<b>Arbason</b> – reliably early large beefsteak. Outdoor/greenhouse Indeterminate	Large Red	
<b>Cherokee Purple</b> – late or best for greenhouse, vigorous plants, purpl-ish fruit with green shoulders, an heirloom favorite. Indeterminate	Large, purple	
<b>Fantastic</b> – late or best for greenhouse; slicers, very solid, crack resistance, meaty, rich in beefsteak flavor, Indeterminate	Large Red	
<b>Brandywine</b> – late or best for greenhouse; flavor to which other tomatoes compared. Not heavy-yielding, up to 7 inches across. Indeterminate	Large red/pink	
<b>Pork Chop</b> – new from Wild Boar (breeding heirlooms for improved quality) Heavy yields, sweet beefsteak, striking yellow with orange shoulders. Osborne grower “blown away” by Pork Chop. Indeterminate	Lrge yellow <b>photo right</b>	
<b>Pink Berkeley Tie-Dye</b> – Osborne favorite in office taste test, nicely balanced between acid and sweet, long production window indoors, disease resistance good; pink/purple with green metallic stripes (another Wild Boar)	Large, red/green <b>photo left</b>
